MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF COPPERLEAF METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 7

Held: Tuesday, April 11, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. via Zoom video/telephone conference. The meeting was open to the public.

A Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Copperleaf Metropolitan District No. 7, County of Arapahoe, State of Colorado, was called and held as shown above and in accordance with the applicable statutes of the State of Colorado, with the following Directors present and acting:

Following discussion, and upon motion duly made by Director Miller, seconded by Director M. Cooper, and upon vote unanimously carried, the Board excused the absences of Directors Jonathan Alpert and Richard Frank.

Disclosure of Potential Conflicts of Interest

Attendance

The Board discussed the requirements of Colorado law to disclose any potential conflicts of interest or potential breaches of fiduciary duty of the Board of Directors to the Secretary of State. The members of the Board were requested to disclose any potential conflicts of interest with regard to any matters scheduled for discussion at this meeting and incorporated for the record those applicable disclosures made by the Board members prior to this meeting in accordance with statute. It was noted by Mr. Sorensen that disclosures of potential conflicts of interest were filed with the Secretary of State for all directors, and no new conflicts of interest were disclosed at the meeting.

Quorum / Meeting Location / Posting of Notices

Mr. Sorensen confirmed the presence of a quorum. The Board entered into a discussion regarding the requirements of Section 32-1-903(1), C.R.S., concerning the location of the District's board meeting.

The Board determined that the meeting would take place via Zoom video/telephone conference. Mr. Sorensen reported that notice was duly posted on the website of the District, and that no objections to the meeting location or the video/telephonic manner of the meeting, or any requests that the meeting location or video/telephonic manner of the meeting be changed by taxpaying electors within the District boundaries have been received.

Approval of Agenda

The Board reviewed the agenda for the meeting. Following review and discussion, and upon motion duly made by Director Miller, seconded by Director M. Cooper, and upon vote unanimously carried, the Board approved the agenda, as presented.

24-Hour Notice Posting Location

Following discussion, the Board designated the location for posting of 24-hour meeting notices as the District website. If the website is unavailable, notice will be physically posted within the 20' x 80' boundaries of the District.

Cancelled May 2, 2023 Regular Directors' Election ("Election") Mr. Sorensen informed the Board that the Election was cancelled, as permitted by statute, as there were not more candidates than seats available. He noted that Directors Alpert, M. Cooper, and R. Frank were each deemed elected to 4-year terms ending in May 2027.

Following review, upon motion duly made by Director M. Cooper, seconded by Director Miller, and upon vote unanimously carried, the Board approved, or ratified approval of (as appropriate) the Consent Agenda items, as follows:

Ms. Hamilton reviewed with the Board the unaudited financial statements for the period ending December 31, 2022.

Following review and discussion, upon motion duly made by Director M. Cooper, seconded by Director Miller, and upon vote unanimously carried, the Board accepted the unaudited financial statements for the period ending December 31, 2022, as presented.
